RULES & REGULATIONS 6 TEAMS

1. All players, will be split across the six teams, that will come to be formed by the organizers.
2. Each innings will be limited to 7 overs only during which there will be no break. Final match will be of 8 overs each.
3. One bowler will be allowed to bowl only for 3 overs, No other bowler will be allowed to bowl more than two overs. The balls to be used will be the ones provided by the officials. No choice will be granted. In Finals two bowlers will be allowed to bowl 3 overs each and maximum one bowler can bowl 2 overs.
4. The rule of wides or no balls – if any bowler bowls 3 wide/ no ball in an over, he will have to be removed and another bowler will have to complete that over. If desired by the team, the bowler can later start a new over, but same rule will apply
5. Batsman will be allowed to bat till their individual score reaches 25 runs and then will be retired not out. (24 runs plus a maximum of six runs will be allowed). He can come to bat after all other players get out.
6. There will be a restriction on the bowlers' run-up as also on the distance between the wicket-keeper and the wickets.
7. Once a team starts playing its match, the players of that team cannot be replaced. Substitution will be permitted only in case of injury. However the substituted players cannot bowl or bat.
8. It would be compulsory for the players to wear abdomen guards.
9. No under-arm bowling will be allowed.
9. Wide ball rule as per limited overs matches shall apply.
11. In case of a batsman getting injured and not being able to continue the batting, he will be deemed to have lost his wicket.
12. The preliminary rounds will be played on a league basis. Each team plays 2 matches. The top 2 teams based on points followed by NRR shall qualify for the finals.
13. Points shall be awarded as follows : 2 points for a win, 1 point each for a ties match, 1 extra point for winning Tug of War. In addition one bonus point will be awarded if:
 - * The team that is batting second scores the runs in 30 balls or less.
 - * The team that is bowling second wins the match & restricts the opposing team to less than 75% of their score.
14. In case of a tie in the Final with the scores being the same then there would be a s"Super Over" Each team will nominate three batsmen and a bowler who will compete in a one over match.
15. The teams must report to the registration desk 30 minutes before the start of the match.
16. Although adequate safety precautions have been taken and medical facilities will be available to treat any injuries sustained while playing, we will not be held responsible and liable for the same and the players will be playing at their own risk.
17. Interpretation of these Rules & Conditions, their construction and effect rests entirely with the Organizing Committee. All decision taken by their committee will be final and binding on all the participants.
18. Owners will be given first priority incase we get more than 48 registrations.

On the boundary lines a carnival atmosphere gets recreated: with live street food and interactive "real" games for families and children including Foot Massage, Fortune Telling, Tu of War, Topsy Turvy, Target shoot, Minute to Win it Challenges and similar activities. There are exciting prizes to be won too!!!

PPL is an ideal way to relax, meet friends from the industry, (also) laugh about the games and unwind in a personal and intimate way. The ones doing well will have boasting rights - as trophies will be handed out at the end.

The organisers BMPA-MMS - assure you that Mar 20th is surely gonna be a fun day in the life of a print house setup.
