## 1. <u>EXTENSION OF NON-PREFERENTIAL CERTIFICATE OF</u> ORIGIN (COO)

- 1. In continuation to the earlier Trade Notice the mandatory filing of applications for Non Preferential Certificate of Origin through the e-CoO Platform has been further extended till 01<sup>st</sup> August 2022.
- 2. While the exporters and NP CoO Issuing Agencies would have the option to use the online system, the same shall not be mandatory till 01st August 2022. The existing systems of processing non-preferential CoO applications in manual/paper mode are being allowed. # **2. UPDATES AND MODIFICATION IN EPCG SCHEME**

DGFT has revised several of its provisions of Handbook of Procedure Chapter 5 with respect to compliance and procedure process under EPCG Scheme.

The Important Provisions of the Public Notice:

- 1. Revised Para 5.14 now allows extension of Block wise fulfillment of EO on payment of composition fee when application is made after 6 months but within 6 years at a late fee of Rs. 10,000/- per authorisation and beyond 6 years at an additional late fee of Rs. 5,000/- for each year.
- 2. Revised Para 5.15 requires EPCG authrosiation holder to submit Annual report of export by 30th June every year through Online method. Any delay in filing such annual report shall be regualarised on payment of Rs. 5000/- as late fees for each financial year per authorisation.

- 3. Revised Para 5.16 clearly now states that EPCG Authorisation will have 10% Automatic enhancement and customs need not require any DGFT RA endorsement on the same. The Fees for the same will also be paid by EPCG holder at the time of EODC Application. EO will automatically proportionately enhance.
- 4. Revised Para 5.17 allows Extension of EO Period beyond 6 Months but within 8 years at payment of late fee of Rs. 10,000/- per authorisation. The Application for EO Extension will also be considered beyond 8 years for regularization purpose with an additional late fee of Rs. 5,000 for each year.
- 5. Revised Para 5.19A provides clear understanding on Annual Average Export Obligation and that it can be used to offset any shortfall in Average EO done in other year(s) of the EO period.

**Effect of this Public Notice:** With a view to enhance ease of doing business and reduce the compliance burden, certain provisions of Chapter 5 related to the Export Promotion Capital Goods Scheme of the Handbook of Procedures (2015-20) are amended for EPCG authorizations issued under Foreign Trade Policy (2015-20).

### **CONSULTATIVE LETTER FOR DUTY DRAWBACK CLAIMS**

- 1. Many Exporters have received Consultative Letters in respect of Duty Drawback claimed in the period 2014-2018. The letter states that as per their records, the Payments against various shipping bills are not closed and thus, the exporter is liable to pay the necessary duty drawback back. However, the exporters are unable to get the list of s/bills and the details referred in the letter.
- 2. To assist in the matter JNCH Customs, has issued a Public Notice No. 20 Dt. 25.03.2022 providing the process and guidelines on the same.
