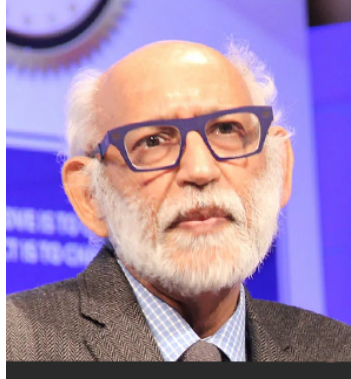


## Naresh Khanna - Profile

Since 1975, worked in India as a printer, and printing industry executive; and, since 1979 as a consultant to publishers, printers, and global organizations in India, Bangladesh, and Nepal. Involved in the computerized implementation of Indian scripts for typesetting. Author, **Miracle of Democracy in India**, Interprint, 1977.

Founded magazines Indian Printer and Publisher in 1979 and Packaging South Asia in 2007. Organizer of the IPP Conferences since 1994 in Delhi, Mumbai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, and Chennai. Smart Packaging for Asia conference in 2021. Trained and Certified G7 Expert in 2016 in Mumbai.

Consultant, and principal researcher of the Indian print, publishing, and packaging industry since 1999 at IppStar ([www.ippstar.org](http://www.ippstar.org)). Indian print and packaging industry research presentations at drupa, Dusseldorf May 2012, the PRIMIR conference at Portland, Oregon in the US August 2007, at AIFMP Goa in India and at Tokyo Pack, Tokyo 2014.

Founded IndiFoodBev and HealthTekPak in 2019. In May 2023 elected as vice-president of the International Packaging Press Organization.
